P1-P4 pupils will have their Summer Disco 6.30pm - 7.30pm


P5-P7 pupils will have their Summer Disco 7.45pm - 8.45pm

Child Protection Volunteers

In accordance with the school's Child Protection Policy I ask all parents who would be interested in assisting voluntarily in any aspect of school life during 2017/2018 academic year (PTA, Transport, Library, School Visits etc.) to complete the on line Access NI form before the end of term. Before beginning the on line application you will require an instruction form including a PIN number. This can be obtained from the school office. On completion of the on line form you will receive a Unique Access NI Number which should be brought into school with ID documents for verification. This procedure must be repeated annually.
