

Child Protection Volunteers

In addition it will be necessary to complete the online Access NI form. Before

beginning the online application you will require an instruction form including a PIN number. This can be obtained from the office. On completion of the online form you will receive a Unique Access NI Number which should be brought into school with relevant ID documents for verification. This procedure must be repeated annually.

Walk to School Week – Week Beginning Monday 20th May 2019



We are planning a Walk to School Week in the week commencing Monday 20th May 2019 (on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday)

There will be two starting points.

- Carniny Road (near the entrance to Carnview Park)
- Old Cullybackey Road (near the entrance to Sunningdale Park)

Children, who usually walk from the Carniny Road starting point, should be dropped off at the 'school <u>side'</u> of the Carniny Road, to avoid crossing the road.

This walking initiative will encourage all children to be more active and will also help alleviate the parking issues we have in the proximity of the school grounds.

Children will be given a coloured sticker during registration to mark their participation in the Walk to School initiative. All children recorded as participating in at least two morning walks to school will be rewarded.

Please note: Due to this initiative being well embedded in the culture of the school we feel that teacher supervision is unnecessary. However, we would encourage parents to take an active role in ensuring pupil safety during their journey to school.
